

# JOINING THE MUDEFORD CLUB

## *Who can join?*

The Club welcomes applications to join from anyone of 18 years+.

All members should be able to enjoy themselves in a safe and pleasant atmosphere so everyone must adopt appropriate language, dress and behaviour when on Club premises obeying both the Rules and Bye-Laws.

We display the names of all applicants within the Club before they are accepted as members. We urge you to review our Privacy Policy on the Club website ([www.themudford.club](http://www.themudford.club)) to see exactly how your data will be used once you apply for membership and thereafter.

## *What are the costs?*

The joining fee is currently £15. This fee covers either one person or a couple wishing to join. **This charge is currently being waived for any person who is the partner of an existing member.**

You will also pay a separate sum of 5p each – which will buy you one share in the Club.

There is a yearly subscription fee (£26 at the time of writing) payable by all members. As a new member, in your first year you will pay part of this sum corresponding to how much of the year remains when you join.

## *Couples – should we both join?*

You don't both have to join - members may bring in their partners at most times. If both join (and pay the yearly subscription) then they are both eligible for discounts or benefits available only to members and both can use the facilities independently, they'll both be shareholders, can propose new members, take part in elections and stand for any office within the Club.

## *What do I do next?*

The application forms to join are available behind the bar (to be completed on the premises) or on the website, and you'll need two existing members to propose and second you. You'll pay the £15 joining fee (plus 5p each for a share), get a receipt and may use the Club as a guest whilst your application is processed. Once accepted, you will be called in one evening for an introduction and you will receive your Welcome Pack.
