# **Green cards**

All members were issued with a green discount card for use at the bar 5 years ago, although a few dozen are still awaiting collection! Note this does not, as some members seem to think, open the front door – that is your

#### white card.

(Also, did you know that, if you wish, you can have your card turned into an Account Card, which means you can put cash on it and use the card to make purchases at the bar. If you want to do this, simply contact the Secretary, we don't need to physically have your card to do it.)

Being a member **DOES NOT** entitle you to discount at the bar. Presenting your green card, **DOES**.

When subs collection is complete, all lapsed member cards will be switched off. Also, the green cards behind the bar will be switched off meaning that if you don't have your green card with you (or are not a member) there will be **NO POSSIBLE WAY** the staff can give you discount, so please don't ask.
