

The Joker's Jackpot - Rules



1. This competition is open ONLY to current, fully paid-up members of The Mundeford Club (the term “members” includes Senior Members, Life Members and staff).
2. The jackpot prize will ONLY be paid upon presentation of photo-ID that confirms the winner is a bona-fide Club member and will be paid by electronic bank transfer (or cheque) in the week following the draw. Payment will ONLY be made to the bank account of the member holding the winning ticket, no other bank account.
3. If the ticket holder is unable to provide this photo-ID at the time of winning, their photo will be taken which must then match the photo-ID required the following week, before any jackpot prize is paid.
4. Winners must be present, in person, and any ticket handed in by anyone other than the purchaser is null and void.
5. Tickets may be purchased by members during a one hour period shortly before the scheduled time of the draw.
6. The draw will take place at approximately 10:20 – 10:30pm every Friday, within The Club. On occasions where the Club might not be open on a Friday evening (e.g. Christmas or New year), the draw will be conducted at lunchtime.
7. A random number generating machine will be used to select a single numbered ticket from the full range of tickets sold that week.
8. The holder of the ticket **MUST** be present and available to participate within three minutes of the ticket number being called. If the person is not present then the number will be re-drawn until a winner is present.
9. The holder of the ticket drawn will receive a £25 prize.
10. They may then select one card from the numbered deck of cards which may be either a physical pack or a simulation displayed on the TV monitors.
11. If the card selected turns out to be an ace, the winner will receive a bonus payment of a further £25.
12. If the card selected is the Joker, the winner becomes eligible for the jackpot prize, subject to meeting all the above conditions.
13. If the Joker is not selected, the remaining prize money from the week's ticket sales will be added to the jackpot and the draw will roll-over to the following week.
14. No prize greater than £25,000 can be paid. Should the jackpot reach this level, it will be capped and any additional money collected will be added to the starting prize for the next draw.
